Because of these qualities, Cedar Falls' Industrial and Technology Parks have become the country's premier destinations for all types of businesses, particularly distribution, logistics, manufacturing, and technology-based companies. The more than 170 companies in our industrial & technology parks employ nearly 7,000 people.

Located on the south edge of the city, the Cedar Falls Industrial and Technology Park is less than 1/2 mile north of U.S. Highway 20, Cedar Falls' freeway link to Interstate 380 and the rest of the nation. Numerous shovel-ready sites are also available, ranging from 1 acre to 100 acres, for industrial and corporate office sites. The park


